

## VISITING THE SWIRE INSTITUTE OF MARINE SCIENCE (SWIMS)

#### 【VISIT TO SWIMS】

The Swire Institute of Marine Science (SWIMS) is a research facility of The University of Hong Kong, situated on the Cape d'Aguiar peninsula (鶴咀), on the shores of Hong Kong's first Marine Reserve. Research focuses on shallow water marine ecosystems specifically on Ecology and Biodiversity, Anthropogenic impacts, Conservation and Management.

SWIMS was originally named as The Swire Marine Laboratory and was comprised of an academic and residential block. The specialized laboratory was facilitated and improved primarily for postgraduate research. This laboratory has created effective use of bench space and a re-organization of items of equipment, whilst maintaining the open, natural light and views of the bay. In addition, SWIMS has upgraded the seawater aquarium with the provision of new cyclone and sand filters to improve the water quality, which means a wide range of marine organisms can now be reared in good conditions in a series of outdoor tanks. The indoor aquarium area has also been re-designed to provide an extremely flexible variety of facilities.



Facilities in SWIMS: Lab facilities, Field facilities, Workshop, Marine aquarium, SWIMS museum, Libraries and Accommodation.
