【 About 】

About High Island Tin Hau Festival

High Island, once a thriving community in the Sai Kung area, with a rich history spanning centuries, has a special event lined up for you. In the past, it was home to thousands of Hakka people and fishermen who were deeply devoted to the worship of Tin Hau. Each year, on the 23rd day of the third lunar month, they still commemorate Tin Hau's birthday with a traditional ceremony. The celebration is divided into two scales: a “big festival” in even-numbered years and a “small festival” in odd-numbered years. This year, it is a big festival from the 19th to the 24th day of the



third lunar month (from 5 May to 10 May 2026), when Chinese opera will be performed in a temporary traditional bamboo theatre; on the 22nd day of the third lunar month (8 May), there will be an awe-inspiring Tin Hau maritime parade, when a fleet of boats follow a boat carrying the Tin Hau statue, creating a vibrant ambiance as they navigate the nearby waters; the main celebration on the 23rd day of the third lunar month (9 May) encompasses dragon dances, lion dances, Hakka unicorn dances and a Fa Pao Ballot.
