Duties

Qualifications

- a) a doctoral degree in a Life Science-related discipline;
- b) at least five years' post-qualification experience, including at least three years' relevant experience in the operation of various mass spectrometers. Possession of solid hands-on experience in mass spectrometry-based targeted and untargeted metabolomics will be an advantage;

- d) strong analytical, interpersonal and communication skills.
